Importance of Working From Home



ESSENTIAL INFORMATION TO YEAR 11 AND 13

- Though GCSE and A Level Exams have been cancelled all courses must be completed
- Grades will be awarded based on the evidence that schools can provide about each pupil and we must have a full evidence base for each learner
- To move onto the next stage of your education you need to be sure that you have full knowledge of the material at your current level
- Though the absence of exams may make it hard to motivate yourselves, the school must be able to provide evidence for potential grades, which will rely in part on the work done over the next few weeks.

What is Available to You?



- The main way for pupils to access school work is via Google Classroom
- Each pupil should be a member of a Google Classroom for each of their classes
- Class teachers will regularly post work on Google Classroom which will replace class learning
- For exam classes teachers will post work which you can then upload and receive feedback.

What is Available to You?



- The Bassaleg School website is being updated to host a wide range of materials to support all learners in addition to Google Classroom
- Core subject material will be available for learners in Years 7 9 including:
 - National Test Practice Papers
 - Skills Building Work
 - Science, English and Maths Material / Project Work
 - Essential Year 9 GCSE English Literature Preparation
- There is also revision guidance for GCSE / A Level Pupils
