

Overview of course content

Religious Studies (short course) is the statutory course provided in school for all students. The distinctive nature of this course is that it involves a thematic study of some of the most important questions and issues in human life and experience.

The course includes the study of:

- 1. An introduction to two World Religions.
- 2. Issues of life and death including science vs Religions, ethical issues including abortion and euthanasia, the origin and sanctity of human life and questions about life.
- 3. Issues of good and evil.

The course gives students the opportunity to study the connections between religion and culture and to consider their own moral values and attitudes. A range of skills are developed during the course, including: the ability to make personal judgements on important moral issues; develop skills of communication and discussion; and the ability to use a variety of sources of information.

Summary of assessment

Assessment is through one examination at the end of the course in Year 11
