How will you ensure consistency in the marking of the assessments?	Assessment of candidates work  Candidates work is assessed by their nominated assessor. Feedback is given orally and in written format. This process follows the requirements of the challenge briefs to ensure that the control requirements are met.  Assessment of evidence will be made against the performance bands within the specification. All assessors are required to highlight where learning performance and performance bands have been achieved.  Students have 2 weeks to appeal marks and if they appeal the work will be assessed by a different assessor. If the marking is outside of a 3 mark tolerance then that assessors marking will be reviewed. ## **Examples**

- A learner achieves a raw mark of 58 in the Project and 26 in Enterprise and Employability Challenge.
   Using UMS converters this gives 122 and 39. 122+39 = 161
   161 out of 210 = 77% This equates to a grade B
- A learner achieves a raw mark of 43 in the Project and had a result from WJEC for the Community with a UMS of 35.
   43 converts to UMS of 99 in the Project. 99 + 35 = 134
   134 out of 195 = 68.7%. This equates to a grade C.
