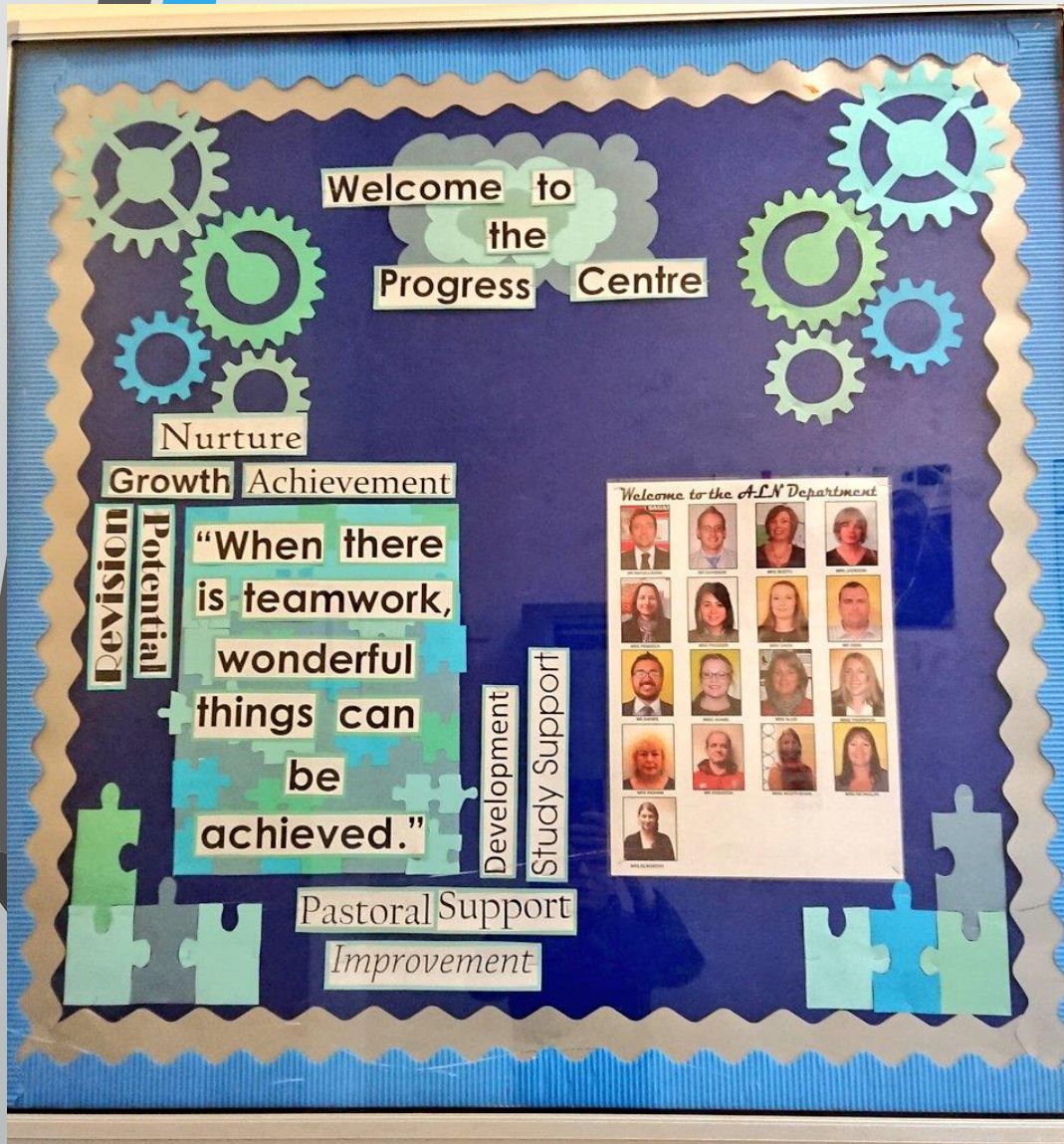

What do we do?



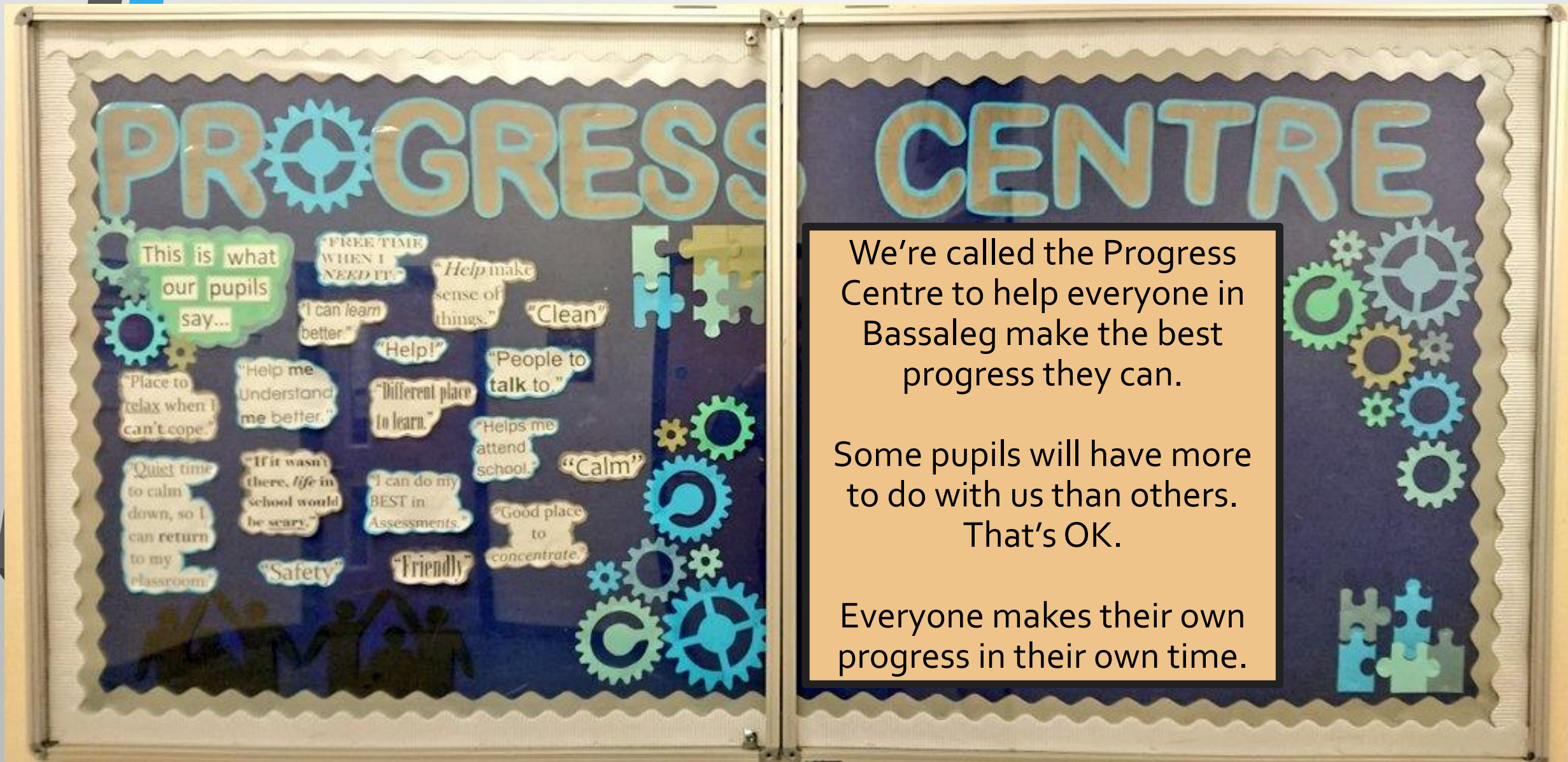
The team here work with pupils across the whole school with a wide range of needs and requirements.
