These scripts will be anonymised and internally moderated. This selection will have a representative sample of pupils with protected characteristics, particularly: eFSM pupils, EAL pupils, LAC, pupils, pupils from non-white ethnicities, young carers and those associated with the school Queer and Straight Alliance group. A clerical check will take place for every assessment sat to ensure that the grades recorded for the assessment are the same as the grades awarded.
