Ethos and spirit of the guidelines

We want to promote an environment in which Sixth Formers set a clear and professional example for the rest of the school. That involves modelling high standards of appearance and comportment at all times, whether in lesson or around the site.

Pupils who refuse to comply with the basic requirements of the policy or who choose to flout these stipulations risk sanction by the Head of Sixth Form in the first instance. Repeated and sustained infringements come with the risk of a pupil being sent home from lessons until such time as they have rectified the issue with their uniform.

Essentials for male pupils

- Tailored black trousers
- Black blazer with school badge
- White collared shirt
- Sixth Form tie
- Black cardigan or black v-neck sweater worn under blazer
- All black sensible shoes

Essential for female pupils

- Tailored black trousers OR
- Black office skirt or pinafore dress (either A line, pleated or straight style of an appropriate length i.e. mid-thigh or longer).
- White shirt
- Sixth Form tie
- Black suit jacket (optional)
- Black cardigan or black v-neck jumper (not thick knit)
- All black sensible shoes.

Prohibited for all pupils

- No hoodies or any variety until Year 13 Leavers' Day
- No trainers
- No jeans or denim coats
- No jeggings or leggings
- No skin tight trousers e.g. skin-tight jeans
- No skirts made of lycra or denim
- No mini-skirts
- No stiletto heels
- No nose rings, although a clear nose stud is permitted
- No unconventional hairstyles
